During an initial period of 12 months (2014.12 till 2015.12), almost 13.000 Elsevier eBooks from more than 20 subject areas are accessible in all Max Planck Society institutions via the <u>MPG eBooks catalog</u>. At the end of this initial period, those eBooks which have been most often accessed will be purchased and available for limitless use.
